MISSISSIPPI WELCOME CENTERS ROOM RESERVATIONS INFORMATION

Attached is an agreement drawn up by the Mississippi Development Authority for hotels/motels and bed & breakfast inns interested in using the Room Reservation Service that has been implemented at Mississippi's twelve Welcome Centers.

This agreement allows Mississippi Welcome Center personnel to make room reservations for travelers. The travelers are given a list of participating accommodations and asked to make a selection. The travel counselor calls the selected accommodation collect or uses a toll-free number. The accommodation should accept the collect call and make reservations for the traveler to be held until 4:00 p.m. or 6:00 p.m. (whichever is applicable), or guarantee rooms for arrivals after 4:00 pm. or 6:00 p.m. with a credit card. The Centers have a form for this purpose, and the traveler is given a copy of the form to present to the accommodation.

There are twelve Welcome Centers in the state.

I-55 north of the Louisiana line – Pike County Welcome Center
I-10 east of the Louisiana line – Hancock County Welcome Center
I-10 west of the Alabama line – Jackson County Welcome Center
I-59 north of the Louisiana line – Pearl River County Welcome Center
I-20 west of the Alabama line – Lauderdale County Welcome Center
I-20 east of the Louisiana line – Warren County Welcome Center
Hwy 82 and Reed Road in Greenville – Washington County Welcome Center
640 south Canal Street in Natchez – Adams County Welcome Center
Hwy 78 west of the Alabama line – Itawamba County Welcome Center
Hwy 45 Bypass in Corinth – Alcorn County Welcome Center
Intersection of Hwy 49 and Hwy 61 – Coahoma County Welcome Center (Oct. 1, 2004)

This program has been operating successfully since April 19, 1991, and has resulted in a substantial increase in the number of room nights booked by participating lodging properties.
